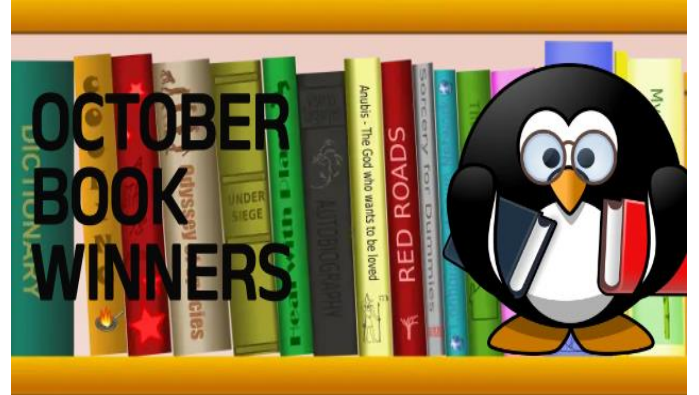
FUN FACTS
